


TRAINING PORTAL INSTRUCTION

Registering on the training portal


Permit applicant registers on the training portal personally at https://register.gimletlms.com/Nordkalk. The link to the training portal can also be found on Nordkalk's homepage at https://www.nordkalk.com/access-to-nordkalks-plant-areas/. The language options for both logging into the education portal and completing the courses are Finnish and English.

Role selection (picture 1)

Tanker drivers who drive lime products choose the role "Silo truck driver (only dry bulk)". All other drivers choose the role "Other driver"

Fill in the information requested in the registration form..

The given email address must be available at the time of logging in to the portal. A login link and password will be sent to thih e-mail.

If there is no company represented by the driver in the company listing, select "Other company" and write the name of the company in the field below.

Confirm reading and acceptance of the privacy policy before registering.

Logging into the training portal


Log in to the training portal at https://nordkalk.community.gimletlms.com/fi. The username is the e-mail address used for registration and the password was sent to that e-mail (picture 3)



Completion of courses

The first training to be completed is the driver's orientation course. Other courses will not appear active until this course is completed. The duration of completing the driver's orientation course is approximately 10-15 minutes, depending on the chosen role and the speed of completion of the course.

After completing the orientation course, a region-specific orientation course must be completed. There are 5 regional orientation courses – Parainen, Tytyri, Sipoo, Lappeenranta and Other locations. By completing the orientation course of Other locations, the driver gets permission to enter the loading areas of Kemi, Raahe, Kokkola, Vimpeli ja Vampula. The driver must only complete the orientation courses for which he needs an access permit. The duration of one area orientation is a maximum of 5 minutes.



Certificate

After completing each area orientation course, the driver will receive a certificate of access permit to his e-mail (picture 5).



When applying for a access identifier or otherwise requested, the driver must prove the validity of the access permit by presenting the e-mail received. Course completions are also automatically registered in the Abloy Os access control system, from which the validity of the access permit can be checked if necessary.

Access ID

The distribution of access IDs (tags) works as before at local dispatch offices or by sending them by post. The condition for granting the access permit, i.e. the approved completion of the regional orientation course, is checked from the access control system. Only approved course completions are registered in the system.
